Aspirin's active ingredient, salicylic acid, significantly reduces your risk of heart attack and prevents blood clots in people with circulatory problems.


In addition to all its pharmaceutical applications, aspirin can also be used for cosmetic purposes. This is due to the various substances it contains.

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An Aspirin-Based Shampoo



The following alternative treatment is very easy to make. **Apply it daily in order to benefit from all the hair-care properties that aspirin has to offer!**

Ingredients

- 3 aspirin tablets
- 3 tablespoons (1 ounce) of shampoo

What should you do?

- Grind the aspirin into a powder using a mortar and pestle.
- Mix it with three tablespoons of your regular shampoo.
- While showering, moisten your hair, then cover it completely with the treatment.
- Leave it on for five minutes, after which you should rinse as usual.
- If you like, continue by applying your favorite conditioner.

A Hair Lotion with Aspirin



The second aspirin-based treatment we recommend is a lotion that will enhance your natural hair color. **Plus it will protect this part of your body against the negative effects of the elements.**

People who've died their hair but want to return to their natural color should definitely use the below lotion!

Ingredients

- 8 aspirin tablets
- 0.1 gallon of water

What should you do?

- Grind the aspirin into a fine powder, and mix it with 0.1 gallon of hot water.
- Pour this mixture into a spray bottle. Apply it to your hair thoroughly.
- Repeat this procedure every night.
- Be sure to shake the bottle well before each use, as the aspirin powder will tend to deposit on its bottom.

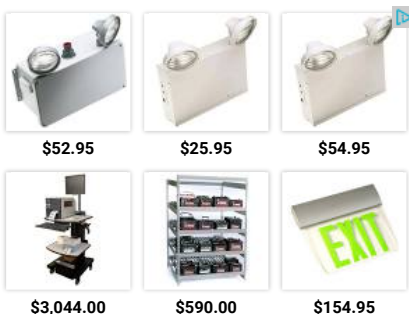
- The effects of the two aspirin hair treatments presented above may vary from person to person. Your hair type and daily habits will play a key role!
